 around the world.

Mathematics Mastery and English Mastery are two of the initiatives that have been incubated through Ark Ventures and are now scaled outside the Ark schools network.

The Head of External Relations is responsible for the planning, development and implementation of all communications and marketing strategies, including media, public and government relations activities.

The role holder will work closely with the Head of Strategic Partnerships and their team on school recruitment and product sales. They will lead on the development and implementation of a fundraising strategy to meet agreed income targets.



The Head of External Relations is a member of the senior management team and reports directly to the Chief Operating Officer of Ark's curriculum programmes. The role holder will also work closely with Ark's Director of External Relations and his teams.

For this senior position we are looking for a driven and dynamic, results-focused individual with relevant experience and a record of success. S/he will have exceptional interpersonal and communication skills. A good knowledge and understanding of the UK's education sector and key issues facing it would be an advantage.

Scope of job

Mathematics Mastery works in partnership with over 500 schools and more than 5,000 teachers to deliver the Mathematics Mastery programme to 150,000+ pupils; English Mastery currently works with 60 partner schools and more than 400 teachers with over 10,000 pupils being taught English Mastery lessons. Both organisations have ambitious plans for growth.

Main responsibilities

- Provide organisational leadership on all aspects of communications, marketing and fundraising.
- Recruit, lead and develop an effective communications team.
- Lead on the planning, development and production of external facing content for all audiences, including digital channels.
- Lead on the development of a cohesive brand strategy and provide clarity and guidance on brand values, visual identity and tone of voice.
- Lead the development and delivery of creative marketing campaigns.
- Build and maintain strong relationships with key external influencers and stakeholders, including partner organisations, supporters and relevant teachers.
- Represent Ark's curriculum programmes at key external forums, with relevant business partners and in the media, acting as a spokesperson as necessary.
- Proactively monitor the news agenda and education landscape, maximising opportunities for reactive commentary.
- Manage, nurture and proactively seek out relationships with key media contacts.
- Provide expert media advice and guidance to colleagues, including briefing spokespeople.
- Lead on the development and implementation of a fundraising strategy to meet agreed organisational income targets, including establishing opportunities for financial support and leading on funding proposals and stewardship of funder relationships.
